### Application Criteria

- Applicant must be of Hispanic Heritage: Persons descended from Mexican, Puerto Rican, Cuban, Dominican, Central American (Excluding Belize), South American (Excluding the Guayanas), or other Spanish Cultures.
- Applicant must be a High School Senior, graduating in 2007.
- Applicants should have a cumulative GPA of at least 2.80 out of a 4.0 GPA Scale. Cumulative GPAs below 2.80, do not qualify for a scholarship.
- Must reside in the United States. Legal status not required.

### Required Documentation

- Official High School issued academic transcript(s) required and included in application.
- Letter of recommendation from school administrator/faculty or community leader demonstrating student leadership and commitment to civic service.
- Personal essay addressing specific questions.

### Application Submission Requirements

- Applications must be postmarked by the deadline to be considered for fall registration of the following school year.
- Applications are only accepted during the 60-day period prior to the deadline. (Between April 27<sup>th</sup> to June 29<sup>th</sup>, 2007)
- Applications received or postmarked after the deadline will not qualify for a scholarship. You will be notified, and you may apply for the next school year.

The value of this year's scholarship is \$4,000.00.
